

Interfaith Statement of Solidarity with Annunciation House

Faith leaders and organizations express their support for the crucial work of Annunciation House in El Paso, Texas, and decry the criminalization of their services.

The undersigned 268 faith leaders and 165 faith-based organizations write to express our unwavering solidarity with Annunciation House, a Catholic organization that accompanies migrants in El Paso, Texas, and to decry Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton's actions targeting it. We are deeply troubled by efforts that appear to target this kind of humanitarian work, which is a significant part of how many people live out their faith. AG Paxton's decision to target Annunciation House through legal actions - with the ultimate goal of shutting it down - is designed to intimidate other faith-based and secular organizations that provide essential humanitarian services to people seeking safety in Texas.

For more than 45 years, Annunciation House has provided hospitality to people seeking safety at the U.S.-Mexico border. AG Paxton's recent actions are an alarming attempt to deter and criminalize the sacred act of providing care for people in need. Annunciation House provides essential hospitality to hundreds of people each day, by sharing food, clothing, shelter, and moments of dignity on an inhumane journey. Most of Annunciation House's guests are fleeing violence and political repression in their home countries. Many are families with young children. Without Annunciation House's services, many of its guests would have nowhere else to go.

Our faith traditions call us to love and serve others, particularly the most marginalized people in society. Many verses in our sacred texts explicitly extend this obligation to immigrants and teach us to love and care for people from outside our home society. The Hebrew Bible says that "You shall love this person as yourself, for you were foreigners in the land of Egypt" (Leviticus 19:34). Annunciation House's work is rooted in Catholic social teaching, which tells believers that they must seek justice in solidarity with the marginalized, "feed the hungry and welcome the stranger" (Matthew 25:35). AG Paxton's actions are an affront, therefore, to our faith traditions and our religious call to serve our neighbors.

Tragically, these legal actions come amid a broader escalation of tactics and rhetoric that vilify migrants for seeking safety, even though the right to seek asylum is recognized in U.S. and international law. Our society has often failed to foster hospitality and a welcoming environment for immigrants. The ideology animating such hostility has led to violence against immigrant communities and their allies. We call on Attorney General Paxton to immediately halt his attack on faith groups serving immigrants. In an atmosphere of increasing criminalization of migration and border militarization in Texas and beyond, we must remain steadfast in our solidarity with our migrant siblings and the organizations that support them.

Annunciation House is a model of service and a beacon of hope for people of faith who put their values into action. Together in one voice, we will continue to loudly proclaim that every person is created in the image of the Divine and deserves safety and respect.
